Christmas Lights

November will see the return of our Christmas Lights throughout the Jewellery Quarter. The bespoke jewellery themed lights will illuminate the dark nights and set the festive mood for the Quarter. There will be an additional 24 new commissioned lights installed this year in addition to the 110 existing displays.

Over 20 people, including members from Good Gym Birmingham and Greenpeace, joined us on Saturday 21st September as we took part in World Clean Up Day. Walking the streets of the JQ, we picked up a total of 28 bags of litter. Thank you to everyone who participated!

Adopt a Station

In our mission to improve the attractiveness of the JQ station, creating a more welcoming environment, planters have now been installed outside the entrance on Vyse Street with an edible garden alongside platform one. The edible garden features a variety of fruits, vegetables and herbs for visitors to pick at their leisure.

Through local sponsors from the JQ community and funding from West Midlands Railway, projects for 2020 will include a new map commissioned by a local Jewellery Quarter artist, vinyl and artistic displays representing Jewellery Quarter heritage; and further projects to enhance the station's urban garden.



Ambassador Update

This month we welcome a new member to the Ambassador Team, Aaron, who will be joining Matt as the second Ambassador. Matt has seen a very busy few months, assisting 540 people in the area and reporting 286 number of issues across the JQ including graffiti, fly tipping and more. Matt also represented the JQ at both the University of Birmingham and the University of Law Freshers Fairs to talk with students about what the JQ has to offer.

Security Update

We continue to partake in discussions with both Birmingham City Council (BCC) and West Midlands Police, airing all concerns related to security within the Quarter. The Local Partnership Delivery Group (LPDG) meetings, that bring together BCC and local partners, have been a useful source for coordinating local resources.

As the nights close in during October, we are hosting free Personal Safety Workshops for members of the JQ business community. First mile

Since we began working with First Mile 12 months ago, we have helped 121 JQ businesses sign up to the subsidised recycling scheme. In total, this has meant that an incredible 127,365 kgs of waste has been recycled rather than going to landfill. That's the equivalent of 746 trees and 96 tonnes of C02 saved.
