ST.PAUL'S SQUARE

St Paul's Square is Birmingham's last remaining Georgian Square, with the stunning Grade 1 listed St Paul's Church at its heart. On Saturday afternoon, the Square will come alive with live music on stage brought to you by the legendary Jam House, with food and drink supplied by the local venues.





Getting Here

By Train/Tram: The Jewellery Quarter has a dedicated train station (JEQ) and two tram stops (St Paul's and Jewellery Quarter). Hop on the tram for £1.50.

By Car: From north-west/north-east take the M6 or M1. From the south/south-east take the M40 or M5. A multi-storey car park is located on Vyse St. and Newhall St.

On Foot: It is a 20 min walk from Birmingham city centre.

By Bus: The Quarter is accessible from the city centre via the 8A, 8C & 101 (Warstone Lane Stop) and 16, 74 and 75 (Great Hampton St Stop).
