St Paul's Square (Page 4-5)

The music festival at St Paul's Square returns for the 3rd time, taking place throughout the afternoon and into the early evening. Celebrating with a special outdoor event within the picturesque St Paul's Square with a whole host of bands playing live music, accompanied by local food & drink from around the Square.

ST. PAUL'S SQUARE

St. Paul's Square, B3 1QU

St Paul's Square is Birmingham's last remaining Georgian Square, with the stunning grade I listed Church at its heart. The church will be open all day with guided tours. On Saturday afternoon, the Square will come alive with live music on stage curated by the legendary Jam House.

In no particular order, performances by:

CHRIS BOWDEN QUINTET

Birmingham-born Chris Bowden is a well-regarded alto saxophonist, composer, and arranger, best known professionally for his album releases in the acid-jazz boom of the '90s and early 2000s. The Bowden Quintet will be performing upbeat Jazz, fused with hip hop and Drum & Bass.

PETE HARRIS QUARTET

Pete's melodic, bluesy and soulful guitar is often compared to the likes of George Benson, Kenny Burrell and Pat Metheny. Expect Jazz Funk standards and some self-penned compositions.

RED LEMONS

These superbly accomplished and very individual musicians come together to perform a vast range of soul & funk favourites from the likes of Aretha Franklin, The Temptations, and Stevie Wonder to Alicia Keys, Duffy, and Plan B.

CIVIL WRONGS

Powerful rock and indie band, playing popular anthem & ballads, led by local guitar hero, David D'Andrade.

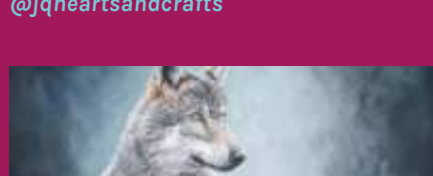

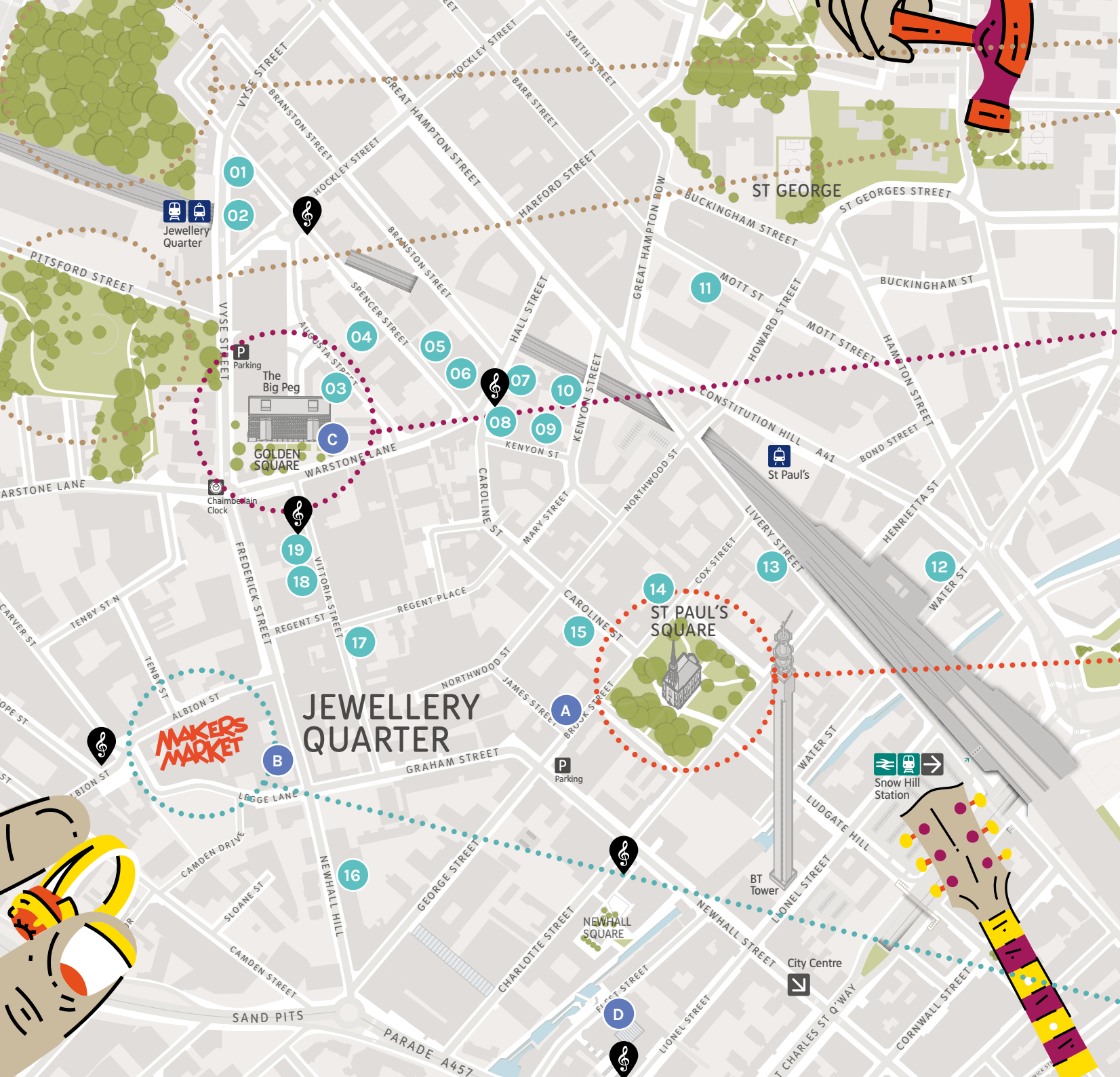

Getting Here

On Foot: It is a 20 min walk from Birmingham city centre.

By Bus: The Quarter is accessible from the city centre via the 8A, 8C & 101 (Warstone Lane Stop) and 16, 74 and 75 (Great Hampton St Stop).
